UST CERTIFICATION SEMINAR

The State of New Jersey Underground Storage Tank (UST) Certification Program requires that all on-site work and report preparation on UST systems be performed by a certified individual. Certifications must be renewed every three years. As a condition of the recertification application, applicants must attend a course on the UST rules and regulations.

The New Jersey Water Environment Association is sponsoring this seminar to assist environmental professionals, contractors and consultants in becoming certified or renewing their certification

This course satisfies the requirements of the P.L. 1991, ch. 123 for attendance at a course approved by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection on the Department's rules governing underground storage tanks

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The NJWEA will present a full day Underground Storage Tank (UST) Certification/Recertification Seminar on Monday September 20, 2010 to be held during the NJWEA Technology Transfer Seminar at the Sheraton Hotel in Eatontown, NJ.

The seminar is a prerequisite for renewal of the 3 year UST Certification. Topics that will be covered include the most recent NJDEP rules and regulations affecting the installation, closure and subsurface evaluation aspects of UST management. Note that NJDEP is now requiring certificate holders, previously "grandfathered" due to education/experience, to take a certification examination.

MEET THE SPEAKERS

Daniel R. Toder, PG, LSP, LSRP, is a Certified Professional Geologist for Hatch, Mott, MacDonald in Millburn, New Jersey managing the Storage Tank Management/Hydrogeology Group. He has extensive experience with underground storage tank management and remediation of soils and groundwater. Mr. Toder was with the NJDEP serving as Section Chief where he was responsible for writing the technical regulations, and technical guidance documents for implementing NJDEP's Underground Storage Tank Program.

Robert T. Cunniff, PG, is a Certified Professional Geologist for Hatch Mott MacDonald in Millburn, N. J. He has 20 years of experience conducting and managing a variety of environmental projects including numerous Underground Storage Tank closures and compliance inspections, as well as other types of investigations and remedial efforts in both soil and ground water. Mr. Cunniff has worked on a wide variety UST sites, both in the NJDEP-regulated, and the Unregulated Heating Oil Tank (UHOT) programs.
