T. William Cleveland Meritorious Service Award

T. William Cleveland, Jr. retired in 1978 at the Licensed Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator for the Township of Livingston after 38 years of devoted service to the municipality. In addition to his professional service, he served 58 years with the Livingston Volunteer Fire Department. He served as President of the North Jersey Section of the New Jersey Water Environment Association, known then as the New Jersey Water Pollution Control Association, from 1984 to 1986. He also served the NJWEA as a dedicated member of the Annual Conference Committee. "Bill" as he was know to his friends, was a fixture at the Annual Conference and Section meetings. He would always be found attending to others in the Conference Hospitality Room or at the Annual Section Picnic. In 1974, the Section created a new recognition award to distinguish an individual member's extraordinary service to the Section. Our dear colleague T. William Cleveland Jr. was the first recipient of what was to become the most prestigious Section Award. Following his receipt of the award, the Section Executive Committee announced that henceforth the North Jersey Section Award for extraordinary service to the Section shall be known as the *T. William Cleveland, Jr. Meritorious Service Award*. Among his many other recognitions, Bill was a Life Member of the NJWEA, a Select Society of Sanitary Sludge Shovelers (S-5) member, and recipient of the Water Environment Federation's Arthur Sidney Bedell and NJWEA's Harry P. Croft Service Awards.

David N. Baker Memorial Service Scholarship

"It is the intent of the membership of the NJWEA North Jersey Section that the David N. Baker Memorial Service Scholarship be awarded to a deserving applicant who, by their sustained actions, has demonstrated a sincere and significant commitment to the service of our nation and to civic and community volunteerism, in much that same spirit as Dave Baker who faithfully served our country, community and organization throughout his life".



David N. Baker was attending the Newark College of Engineering (now known as New Jersey Institute of Technology) when he answered the call to serve our country and he served with distinction. As a United States Army Staff Sergeant during the Vietnam War Dave was awarded the Silver Star for "Gallantry in Action". During Staff Sergeant Baker's 13 months "in country" he also received 3 Purple Hearts because of injuries sustained in combat, one of which were duty to wounds he sustained when he and a fellow soldier were the target of a Vietnamese mortar round. Dave was also awarded the Bronze Star for "Bravery Under Fire."

Staff Sergeant Baker's Silver Star was earned during a firefight that when his unit was taking on fire he felt compelled to assist the medic who was dragging wounded soldiers back under cover. When his Unit's machine gunner was wounded Staff Sergeant Baker ran to the machine gun position and manned the weapon, providing cover fire to allow the additional wounded to be dragged to safety.

Following his tour in Vietnam, Staff Sargent Baker served on a burial detail choosing to honor the fallen in that capacity for the remainder of his commitment to the United States Army. In civilian life he retired as Director of Public Works for the Village of Ridgewood, NJ in 2005 having worked for the village for 38 years. He was a NJ Certified Public Works Manager, a member and Past Regional President of the NJ Public Works Association and Past President of the North Jersey Section of the New Jersey Water Environment Association. He also served on the NJWEA Executive Committee and was the recipient of numerous professional awards.

David N. Baker Memorial Scholarship 2025 Recipient Kiley Shatzel

Kiley Shatzel is a senior at Jefferson Township High School. She has a weighted GPA of 4.445 and unweighted GPA of 4.00. She is in the National Honor Society, Science National Honor Society, and Math National Honor Society and is also in the inaugural class of the STEM Academy at Jefferson Township High School.
